Attendance

Mrs Kemp shared the rewards and incentives for good attendance – see attached.

Attendance bear for each key stage.

Reading – Book Bucks

Mrs Eley shared the Book Bucks system being introduced to encourage pupils to read more.

- Pupils earn Book Bucks by reading books – they get 1 or 2 for each book they read (depending on the thickness of the book).
- Book Bucks can be exchanged for prizes.
- They can either spend them straight away on small prizes (e.g. pencils, erasers) or save them for bigger prizes.
- School council members asked for ideas for prizes – what prizes would motivate them to read?
