Children would like:

- stronger squash

## AOB – concerns raised by class mates and future topics pupils want to discuss

- Want water fountain outside in KS2 as some adults do not allow pupils to go in and get a drink
- Change the smell in the boy's toilets (e.g. air freshener) as the smell can sometimes impact on year 6 corridor
- Want more toilet paper
- Current friendship stop is tatty and chipped – needs to be made more special
- Want trampoline and swing set on the playground
- Want equipment out for break
- Currently not able to use stage in KS2 playground as there is not an adult to supervise that area
- Astroturf requested so a larger area can be used in ban weather
- Would like to use the fish pond area
- Want more equipment outside - Mrs Hunt explained that new lunchtime equipment has been ordered but it is important that children look after it as new equipment is often bought but is quickly lost or broken.
- Want to be allowed to bring in Pokemon cards and Match Attacks for TOPs time
- Children have commented on some areas that look like they need painting and fixing/mending – want the school/building to look nice
