Department for Education Vision for the Primary PE and Sport Premium

ALL pupils leaving primary school physically literate and with the knowledge, skills and motivation necessary to equip them for a healthy, active lifestyle and lifelong participation in physical activity and sport.

At Whitmore, we recognise the contribution of PE and sport to the health and well-being of the children. We believe that an innovative, varied PE curriculum and extra-curricular opportunities have a positive influence on the concentration, attitude and academic achievement of all our children.

Our Primary School PE and Sport's Funding will enable us to continue and extend our provision through employing additional sports professionals, entering into more competitive sports competitions and training our staff to deliver in-house quality PE sessions.

This means that we will use the premium to:

- develop or add to the PE and sport activities that our school already offers*
- build capacity and capability within the school to ensure that improvements made now will benefit pupils joining the school in future years*

To achieve self-sustaining improvement in the quality of PE and sport in primary schools. It is important to emphasise that the focus of spending must lead to long lasting impact against the vision (above) that will live on well beyond the Primary PE and Sport Premium funding. To this end our planned expenditure enables:

- Staff can continue to lead on PE lessons with greater confidence and increased skills
- Continue participating in partnership/local sporting tournaments
- Listen and react upon pupil voice to ensure we continue to also meet healthy school status

Primary PE and Sport Grant 2018/19

There are 5 key indicators that Whitmore should expect to see improvement across:

- *the engagement of all pupils in regular physical activity – (aim towards 30mins daily)*
- *the profile of PE and sport is raised across the school as a tool for whole-school improvement*
- *increased confidence, knowledge and skills of all staff in teaching PE and sport*
- *broader experience of a range of sports and activities offered to all pupils*
- *increased participation in competitive sport*

And

- *how many pupils within their year 6 cohort are meeting the national curriculum requirement to swim competently, confidently and proficiently over a distance of at least 25 metres, use a range of strokes effectively and perform safe self-rescue in different water-based situations*
